The overall design of the kitchen is very modern, with off-white gloss cabinets and black granite worktops. Handles, appliances, socket plates and furniture are made from stainless steel, with a matte appearance that contrasts beautifully with the high-shine cabinets and surfaces. A black and silver palette has also been selected for accessories such as the utensil holders, kettle and coffee

machine, giving the room an elegant monochrome look.
